NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the 8th Annual General Meeting of the members of MVL Limited will be held on Wednesday, September 30, 2015 at 01.00 P.M. at Executive Club, 439, Village Shahoorpur, P.O. Fatehpur Beri, New Delhi-110074, to transact the following businesses:

Ordinary Business:

- To consider and adopt:
 - the audited financial statement of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2015 and Profit and Loss Account for the year ended on that date together with the reports of the Board of Directors and Auditors thereon; and
 - the audited consolidated financial statement of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2015 and Profit and Loss Account for the year ended on that date.
- To appoint a Director in place of Mr. Prem Adip Rishi (DIN: 00020611), who retires by rotation and being eligible, offers himself for re-appointment.
- To appoint a Director in place of Mr. Praveen Kumar (DIN: 01332414), who retires by rotation and being eligible, offers himself for re-appointment.
- To ratify the appointment of M/s. Arun Kishore & Co., Chartered Accountants (ICAI Regd.No. 001898N), as Statutory Auditors of the Company from the conclusion of the ensuing Annual General Meeting until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting of the Company and to fix their remuneration.

Special Business:

5. Appointment of Mr. Rakesh Gupta as Whole Time Director & Chief Financial Officer of the Company

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification, the following resolution as a **Special Resolution**:

Resolved that pursuant to the provisions of Sections 196, 197, 203, 188 & any other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules made thereunder (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force) read with Schedule V to the Companies Act, 2013, the approval of shareholders of the Company be and is hereby accorded for the change in designation of Mr. Rakesh Gupta (DIN:00020638), who is presently Whole Time Director of the Company to the position of **Whole Time Director & Chief Financial Officer** of the Company w.e.f. 01/02/2015 for the remaining terms of his employment as Whole Time Director of the Company (i.e. upto 30/11/2018) without any revision in his remuneration.

Resolved further that the Board of Directors or Committee thereof, be and are hereby severally authorised to alter, revise, amend, vary, enhance or modify, from time to time, the terms and conditions including terms of agreements and remuneration payable to Mr. Rakesh Gupta (DIN:00020638), as **Whole Time Director & Chief Financial Officer** of the Company, subject however to the ceilings laid down in Schedule V of the Companies Act, 2013.

Resolved further that if, in any financial year, the company has no profits or its profits are inadequate, the company shall not pay to Mr. Rakesh Gupta, by way of remuneration any sum exclusive of any fees payable to directors under Section 197 (5) hereunder except in accordance with the provisions of Schedule V and if it is not able to comply with such provisions, with the previous approval of the Central Government.

Resolved further that the Board of Directors or Committee thereof, be and are hereby severally authorised to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as may be deemed necessary to give effect to above resolutions."

6. Appointment of Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik as an Independent Director of the Company

To consider and if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following Resolution as an **Ordinary Resolution**:-

Resolved that pursuant to the provisions of Section 149, 152 and all other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014 read with Schedule IV (including any

statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force), consent of the Members be and is hereby accorded to the appointment of Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik (DIN: 01275161), in respect of whom the Company has received a notice in writing from a member, proposing his candidature for the office of Independent Director of the Company, for a period of 5 (five) consecutive years effective from the date of his appointment, as such by the Board **AND THAT** he shall not be liable to retire by rotation.”

7. **Borrowing Limits under Section 180(1) (c) of the Companies Act, 2013**

To consider and if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following Resolution as a **Special Resolution**:-

“**Resolved that** in supersession of resolution passed by Postal Ballot on 14th March, 2011, the consent of the Company be and is hereby accorded to the Board of Directors (“Board”) in terms of Section 180(1)(c) and all other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force), to borrow from time to time any sum or sums of money for the purpose of Company’s business, notwithstanding that the monies to be borrowed together with monies already borrowed by the Company (apart from temporary loans obtained or to be obtained from the Company’s Bankers in the ordinary course of business) may exceed the aggregate for the time being of paid-up capital of the Company and free reserves (Reserves not set apart for any specific purpose), provided that the aggregate of the monies so borrowed and/or to be borrowed and outstanding at any time shall exceed Rs. 1500.00 Crores (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Crores only).

Resolved further that for the purpose of giving effect to this resolution, the Board be and is hereby authorised to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may in its absolute discretion deem necessary, proper or desirable and to settle any question, difficulty or doubt that may be necessary, proper, desirable or expedient to give effect to this resolution.”

8. **Maintenance of the Register of Members and related books at a place other than the Registered Office of the Company**

To consider and if thought fit, to pass with or without modification(s), the following Resolution as a **Special Resolution**:-

“**Resolved that** pursuant to the provisions of Section 94 and all other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, the Company hereby approves to keep and maintain the Register of Members/ debenture holders/other security holders, the index of members/debenture holders/other security holders required to be kept and maintained by a Company under Section 88 and copies of all annual returns prepared, together with the copies of certificates and documents required to be annexed thereto under Sections 92 of the Act, other statutory registers and other related books be kept and maintained at the Corporate Office of the Company at **MVL iPark, 6th Floor, Near Red Cross Society, Chandan Nagar, Sec-15(II), Gurgaon-122001, Haryana** with effect from **13/08/2015**.

Resolved further that the Registers, Indexes, Returns, documents etc. as aforesaid be kept open for inspection and/or making extract there from on any working day as provided in Section 94 (2) and (3) of this Act”.

Notes:

1. **A member entitled to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on a poll instead of himself and the proxy need not be a member of the Company. The instrument appointing the proxy should, however, be deposited at the registered office of the Company not less than forty-eight hours before the commencement of the Meeting.**
A person can act as a proxy on behalf of members not exceeding fifty and holding in the aggregate not more than ten percent of the total share capital of the Company carrying voting rights. A member holding more than ten percent of the total share capital of the Company carrying voting rights may appoint a single person as proxy and such person shall not act as a proxy for any other person or shareholder.
2. The Register of Members and Share Transfer Books of the Company will remain closed from **Friday, 25th September, 2015 to Wednesday, 30th September, 2015** (both days inclusive).
3. A Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 relating to the Special business to be transacted at the Meeting is annexed hereto.
4. Members are requested to bring their attendance slip alongwith their copy of Annual Report to the meeting.
5. In case of joint holders attending the meeting, the Member whose name appears as the first holder in the order of names as per the Register of Members of the Company will be entitled to vote.
6. Members holding shares in demat form are requested to intimate immediately any change in their address or bank mandates to their Depository Participants with whom they are maintaining their demat accounts. Members holding shares in physical form are requested to advice any change in their address or bank mandates immediately to the Company/ Alankit Assignments Limited (Alankit).
7. The Company has entered into agreement with NSDL and CDSL for dematerialization of shares. Members who still hold the shares of the Company in the physical form are advised to have their holdings dematerialized in their own interest through authorized Depository Participants.
8. Members who hold shares in physical form in multiple folios in identical names or joint holding in the same order of names are requested to send the share certificates to Alankit, for consolidation into a single folio.
9. Corporate members intending to send their authorised representatives to attend the Meeting are requested to send to the Company a certified true copy of the Board Resolution authorising their representative to attend and vote on their behalf at the Meeting.
10. The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has mandated the submission of Permanent Account Number (PAN) by every participant in securities market. Members holding shares in electronic form are, therefore, requested to submit their PAN to their Depository Participants with whom they are maintaining their demat accounts. Members holding shares in physical form can submit their PAN to the Company/Alankit.
11. The notice of Meeting alongwith the Annual Report 2014-15 is being sent by electronic mode to those Members whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company/Depository Participants, unless any Member has requested for a physical copy of the same. For Members who have not registered their e-mail addresses, physical copies are being sent by the permitted mode. Members who have not registered their e-mail addresses are requested to register the same with the Alankit/Depository Participants for receiving all communications including Annual Report, Notices, Circulars, etc. from the Company electronically.
12. Brief resume of Directors including those proposed to be appointed/re-appointed, nature of their expertise in specific functional areas, name of companies in which they hold directorships and memberships/ chairmanships of Board Committees, shareholding and relationships between directors inter-se as stipulated under Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement with the Stock Exchanges are given in the Corporate Governance Report forming part of the Annual Report.
13. The e-voting period commences on Sunday, September 27, 2015 (9.00 a.m. IST) and ends on Tuesday, September 29, 2015 (5.00 p.m. IST). During this period, Members of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date of September 23, 2015, may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. Once the vote on a resolution is cast by the Member, he shall not be allowed to change it subsequently.
14. The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares of the paid up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date, which is September 23, 2015. A person whose name is recorded in the Register of Members or in the Register of Beneficial Owners maintained by the Depositories as on the cut off date only shall be entitled to avail the facility of remote e-voting, voting through Ballot Form as well as voting at the AGM.



- 15. Mr. V. Ramasamy, Proprietor of V. Ramasamy & Co., a firm of Practicing Company Secretary (Membership No. FCS 6191, C.P. No. 6618) has been appointed as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the remote e-voting process as well as voting through post in a fair and transparent manner.
- 16. The Scrutinizer after the conclusion of voting at the Annual General Meeting, will first count the votes cast at the Meeting and thereafter will unblock the votes in the presence of at least two witnesses not in the employment of the Company. The Scrutinizer will collate the votes cast at the Meeting, votes downloaded from the e-voting system and votes received through post and make not later than two days from the conclusion of the Meeting, a Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of total votes cast in favour or against, if any, forthwith to the Chairman of the Company or a person authorised by him in writing who shall countersign the same.
- 17. The results declared along with the Scrutinizer's Report shall be placed on the Company's website www.mvl.in and on the website of NSDL www.evoting.nsdl.com immediately after the result is declared. The Company shall simultaneously forward the results to the BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange of India Limited, where the shares of the Company are listed.

STATEMENT [Pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act')]

The following Statement sets out all material facts relating to the Special Business mentioned in the accompanying Notice:

Item No. 5

Mr. Rakesh Gupta (DIN:00020638), aged 50 years is a Fellow member of The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. He has over 26 years of vast experience in finance, accounts, taxation and commercial matters. He has been serving the Company as director since incorporation and further with the approval of shareholders at the 7th Annual General Meeting of the Company held on 30th September, 2014, was appointed as Whole Time Director of the Company for a period of 5 years with effect from 1st December, 2013.

Keeping in view his long term association with the company and his enticing efforts towards the growth of the company, the Board of Directors, in their meeting held on 14th February, 2015, considered his services and association with the Company necessary for further growth of the Company.

As required under the provisions of Section 203 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules thereunder regarding appointment of Key Managerial Personnel, the Board of Directors considered to re-designate him as Whole Time Director & Chief Financial Officer of the Company and upon recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, appointed him as Whole Time Director & Chief Financial Officer of the Company with effect from 1st February, 2015 upto 30th November, 2018 (i.e. for the remaining terms of his employment as Whole Time Director of the Company).

He holds directorship in below mentioned Companies:

He is holding 72,234 equity shares in the capital of the Company as on 31st March, 2015.

Item No. 6

The Board of Directors (Board) of the Company has proposed the appointment of Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik as Independent Directors of the Company for a period of 5 (five) years effective from the date of their appointment, as such by the Board.

Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik does not hold any share in the Company and he is not related to any other Director of the Company.

Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik has furnished a declaration to the Company that he meets with the criteria of independence, as prescribed for Independent Directors under Section 149 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Rules made thereunder (Act).

In the opinion of the Board, Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik fulfils the conditions for his appointment, as Independent Directors of the Company, as specified in the Act and the Listing Agreement, and he is independent of the Management of the Company.

Keeping in view their vast experience and knowledge, the Board is of the view that it will be in the interest of the Company that Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik is appointed as Independent Director on its Board.

Upon the approval of the Members to his appointment, as Independent Director, the appointment of Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik, as such, shall be formalised by the Board by issuing a letter of appointment to him, which shall be open for inspection by the Members at the Registered Office of the Company, in terms of Section 149(8) and Schedule IV (IV) of the Act.

In terms of Section 149 of the Act, an Independent Director can hold office, as such, on the Board of the Company for 2 (two) consecutive terms of upto 5 years each, such appointment having received the prior approval of the Members of the Company. Also an Independent Director is not liable to retire by rotation.

Brief resume of Mr. Vinod Kumar Malik, nature of his expertise in specific functional areas and names of Companies in which he hold directorships and memberships/chairmanships of Board Committees, shareholding and relationships between directors *inter-se* as stipulated under Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement with the Stock Exchanges, are provided in the Corporate Governance Report forming part of the Annual Report.

Accordingly, the Board recommends the resolution for his appointment, as Independent Director of the Company, for the approval by the Shareholders, as Ordinary Resolutions set out at Item No. 6 of the Notice.

None of the other Directors/Key Managerial Personnel of the Company/their relatives are, in any way, concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in these resolutions.

The members by way of postal ballot, the result of which was declared on 14th March, 2011 had approved under Section 293(1)(d) of the Companies Act, 1956 the Borrowing limit upto Rs. 1500.00 Crores (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Crores only). General Circular No.4 dated 25th March, 2014 issued by MCA has clarified that the resolution passed under section 293 of the Companies Act, 1956 prior to 12th September, 2013 with reference to borrowings (subject to the limits prescribed) and/or creation of security on assets of the company will be regarded as sufficient compliance of the requirements of Section 180 of the Companies Act, 2013 for a period of one year from the date of notification of Section 180 of the Act i.e. upto 31st March, 2015.

The Company is in the business of real estate. The Company might have to consider raising funds, presently estimated at not more than Rs. 1500.00 Crores, at competitive rates of interest, either as non encumbered loans and / or by creating charge over its assets. As the proposed borrowings may exceed the limits laid down under Section 180(1) (c) of the Companies Act, 2013, the approval of the members would be required for the proposed borrowings.

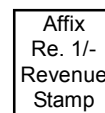
